Competition

Over the past 25 years, the Gold Crown High School Summer Team Camps has grown to be one of the largest team camps in Colorado with teams from throughout Colorado, the Rocky Mountain and Midwest regions. **The 2019 camp included 192 teams from 93 different high schools** including numerous state champions and highly ranked large, medium and small school teams.

Divisions

Teams will be seeded prior to each camp to balance competition. **Camp I Divisions:** Div.: II (Large Sch. JV); Div.: III (Medium/Small Sch. JV/Large Sch. Soph.); Div.: IV (Freshmen). **Camp II Divisions:** Div.: IAA (Large Sch. Varsity); Div.: IA (Large/Medium Sch. Varsity); Div.: IB (Medium/Small Sch. Varsity). *Small school varsity teams will be allowed to play in Camp I (if applicable).

Game Schedule/Camp Format

All games will be played at the six-court Gold Crown Field House (no off-sites will be used). **Each team will play two pool play games per day for a total of six games** (no tournament on the final day of camp). All teams will play back to back games within two hours. Game times will range from 8:00am – 10:30pm.

Health/Safety Guidelines

Everyone entering the Field House will be required to have a temperature scan and answer screening questions. Players and coaches will be required to wear masks upon entry and exit of the building but can remove masks during competition. Teams will only be allowed to have a limited number of players, coaches and spectators in the building (number TBD). We will continue to monitor Health/Safety Guidelines and communicate with teams accordingly.

Game Rules

Games will consist of two 20-minute running clock halves with the clock stopping on all dead balls in the last two minutes of both the first and second half. With the exception of the last two minutes of the second half, shooting fouls will consist of 1 point and 1 free-throw attempt (2 points and 1 free-throw attempt when fouled on a 3-point field goal).

Camp Officiating

Gold Crown will assign 2 officials for Camp I games. **Verne Harris Officiating Camp will assign 3 college and/or HS varsity officials for Camp II games.**

Team Fees/Multiple Team Discounts

\$620 per team. Programs who register two or more teams will receive a \$50 discount for each additional team registered. **Reg. deadline: July 16, 2020.**
