

Gold Crown HS Summer Team Camp

30th Annual Boys Camp: June 12-14, 2025



Competition

Over the past 30 years, the Gold Crown High School Summer Team Camp has grown to be one of the largest team camps in Colorado with competition from throughout Colorado, the Rocky Mountain and Midwest regions. In 2024, 188 teams from five different states attended the camp, including numerous state champions and highly ranked large, medium and small school teams.

Game Sites

Games played at the six-court **Gold Crown Field House, the Rocky Mountain region's premier basketball facility.**Additional sites include Regis University and other facilities/high schools in the Denver Metro area. Most off-sites are located within 15-30 minutes of the Field House.

Divisions

Teams are seeded for pool play prior to the camp. This process allows for a **high level of play and competitive balance in each of the six divisions:** <u>Division: IAA</u> (Large School Varsity); <u>Division: IA</u> (Large/Medium School Varsity); <u>Division: II</u> (Medium/Small School Varsity); <u>Division: II</u> (Large School Junior Varsity); <u>Division: III</u> (Medium/Small School Junior Varsity/Large School Sophomore); Division: IV (Freshmen).

Camp Format/Schedule

All teams are guaranteed 6 games (with the potential to play 7). Game schedule: June 12 (10:00 am-9:00 pm); June 13 (10:00 am-9:00 pm); June 14 (8:00 am-5:00 pm). Format for Divisions IAA, IA and IB: two pool play games on June 12; two pool play games on June 14. Format for Divisions II, III and IV: Two pool play games on June 12; two pool play games on June 13; two or three pool play games on June 14 (teams who win their pool will play one additional game on June 14). In most cases, teams will play their pool play games within a 2 to 4 hour timeframe. Note: Game times are subject to scheduling, gym availability, etc.

Game Rules

All games will consist of **two 20-minute running clock halves** with the clock stopping on all dead balls in the last two minutes of the second half (further explanation of the rules TBA).

Camp Officiating

The Verne Harris Officiating Camp will assign three college officials for all games at the Field House. The Peak2Peak Officiating Camp will assign three college officials for select games played at Regis University (June 13 and 14 only).

Gold Crown will assign two officials for all games not assigned by officiating camps.

Team Fee

\$725 per team. For programs who register multiple teams, the fee is \$675 for each additional team.
