Background

Mission: "Educating youth and community through sports and enrichment programs."

Founded in 1986 by former Denver Nuggets Player Bill Hanzlik, and Denver business leader, Ray Baker, Gold Crown Foundation offers basketball, volleyball, golf and enrichment programs to more than 18,000 youth annually. The Foundation offers camps, clinics, leagues and tournaments for 6 – 18 year olds in Colorado and surrounding states.

Gold Crown offers almost \$550,000 per year in scholarship opportunities

Gold Crown Enrichment is a free, drop-in program that operates throughout the year at two locations; the Best Buy Teen Tech Center in Lakewood and the Gold Crown Clubhouse at Edgewater. Both Clubhouses are the only two certified Clubhouse Network locations in Colorado. The Clubhouse Network consists of more than 100 locations in 18 different countries.

Since opening its doors 14 years ago, more than 6,000 youth have passed through Gold Crown Enrichment. This program allows under-resourced youth the opportunity to explore their interests through state-of-the-art technology in a welcoming and safe environment.

Gold Crown Foundation operates three sports complexes; Coca-Cola All Star Park, Gold Crown Field House and Junior Golf Learning Center.

The 56,000 square foot Field House sees approximately 500,000 people come through its doors each year and is booked more than 300 days.

Coca-Cola All Star Park opened in 1998 in conjunction with the MLB ALL Star game. It is 90% to scale of Coors Field and is the current home field for Colorado Christian University's baseball program. ASP also hosts CHSAA state baseball playoffs every spring.

The Junior Golf Learning Center is located adjacent to the first tee at Eagle Trace Golf Club in Broomfield. This three-acre facility opened in 2007 and hosts Gold Crown Junior Golf Camps.
