



COVID Safety Compliance Protocol

This protocol was developed based on the State of Colorado Safer-At-Home (Recreation) guidelines. This document can be found at <https://covid19.colorado.gov/safer-at-home/recreation#indoor>

- **Number of Participants/Spectators** – In order to be in capacity compliance, we will enforce limits on the amount of people allowed into the Gold Crown Field House.
 - The Gold Crown Field House will be split into six rooms using curtains and dividers.
 - Only 23 individuals per team will be allowed into the Field House. This includes coaches, players, one volunteer scorekeeper and parents/spectators.
 - Waivers must be completed prior to entering (<https://form.jotform.com/202126817379964>).

- **Social Distancing**
 - **Spectators** – All spectators will be required to observe social distancing from other spectators and participants.
 - **Participants** – During Gold Crown events participants will not be required to keep social distancing during competition. However, during any downtime (check-in, to and from the court, etc.) social distancing will be encouraged.

- **Masks** – Coaches, players, spectators and facility staff will be required to wear masks at all time.

- **Cleaning** – All surfaces including equipment and common space will be cleaned between each time block. However, we still encourage all spectators and participants to limit contact with surfaces in the facility as much as possible. Bring your own ball, water bottle, towel, etc. to ensure your limited contact with common items and surfaces.

- **Facility Entry/Exit** –
 - All participants and spectators will enter and exit the building from designated doors. These doors will be determined and monitored by event staff. This is to ensure social distancing and limit the amount of foot traffic throughout the building.
