

GOLD CROWN FOUNDATION/FIELD HOUSE SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

At Gold Crown Foundation, your child's safety and well-being will always be the highest priority for us. As we navigate the best practices in which to re-open the Gold Crown Field House and operate Gold Crown Programs, we have developed the following guidelines in consultation with the CDC, state and local public health guidelines, as well as our partners at Children's Hospital Colorado. Please review our current guidelines.

Safety Guidelines

- **Do not enter the Gold Crown Field House if you show any symptoms related to COVID-19, including but not limited to: cough, shortness of breath/difficulty breathing, fever ($\geq 100.4^{\circ}\text{F}$), chills, body/muscle aches (not related to physical activity), fatigue, sore throat, runny nose, loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, or vomiting. Please be respectful of other guest's safety and practice social distancing and proper hygiene at all times. Gold Crown Foundation reserves the right to deny access or remove any persons from our premises for any reason.**
- All persons entering the Gold Crown Field House are required to maintain a distance of 6 feet from each other and wear a face mask/covering at all times. This includes participants during competition. If you do not have a face covering, one will be supplied to you.
- There are spectator to participant ratio restrictions at the Gold Crown Field House based on the program design. Numbers will be capped based on the current state and local occupancy guidelines. Reservations MUST get pre-approval to allow spectators.

Facility Precautions

- Additional hand sanitizer stations are located in the lobby and public restrooms.
- High traffic areas will continue to be sanitized before, during, and after every event. Our overnight and event cleaning crews will continue to perform daily, detailed cleanings.
- Weekly restroom cleaning services provided by Enviro-Master includes non-corrosive, non-toxic, EPA-registered disinfectant that kills 47 pathogens including norovirus, hepatitis, and COVID-19.
- There will be no available seating for spectators. All tables, chairs, and bleachers have been removed. Spectators are allowed to bring their own seats (i.e. camping chair) as long as they do not scratch the floor.
- Please bring your own water bottle. Water will be available for purchase through our vending machines or at water fountains around the facility. .

Gold Crown Foundation reserves the right to close the Gold Crown Field House and/or suspend any program in the event of an ill participant, coach or spectator.

I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 while participating may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, Gold Crown Foundation employees, volunteers, and program participants and their families.
