



## Gold Crown Summer Golf Cup Points 2026

<b>Participation</b>	<b>15 Points</b>
<b>Scores Under Par</b>	<b>100 Points</b>
<b>Scores from Even Par to +5</b>	<b>85 Points</b>
<b>Scores from +6 to +10</b>	<b>70 Points</b>
<b>Scores from +11 to +15</b>	<b>50 points</b>
<b>Scores from +16 to +20</b>	<b>30 Points</b>
<b>Scores from +21 to +25</b>	<b>20 Points</b>
<b>Scores +26 and above</b>	<b>10 Points</b>

### Rules and Information:

All players must play all holes in the tournament to receive Gold Crown Cup points toward their season total (18 for HS and 9 for MS). You can play in as many tournaments as you want, and all your participation points will count towards your season total. For example, if you play in all eight tournaments, you will receive 15 points for each of those tournaments which will total 120 points for your Gold Crown Cup Total. **However, Gold Crown will only take each player's top 3 finishes of points to add to their Cup Total.** Please note the example below to better understand and reference the points chart above.

For example, if Player A plays in 6 tournaments and their total scores are: +12, +18, +20, +21, +14, and +10, they would receive the following point totals for each tournament (50, 30, 30, 20, 50, 70). Gold Crown would take the top 3 finishes, which would be 50, 50, and 70 points which would total 170 points. But, since Player A played in 6 tournaments, they get 15 points each for those tournaments which would be an additional 90 points. Therefore, Player A's final Gold Crown Cup points for the summer season would be  $170 + 90 = 260$ .

*\*Tiebreakers for the end of season winner will be determined by who has the lowest round to par. If there is a still tie after their lowest round, we will then look at their second-best round, third, etc. If the tie continues until one player has played in more tournaments than the other, the winner will go to the player that played in more tournaments.*
